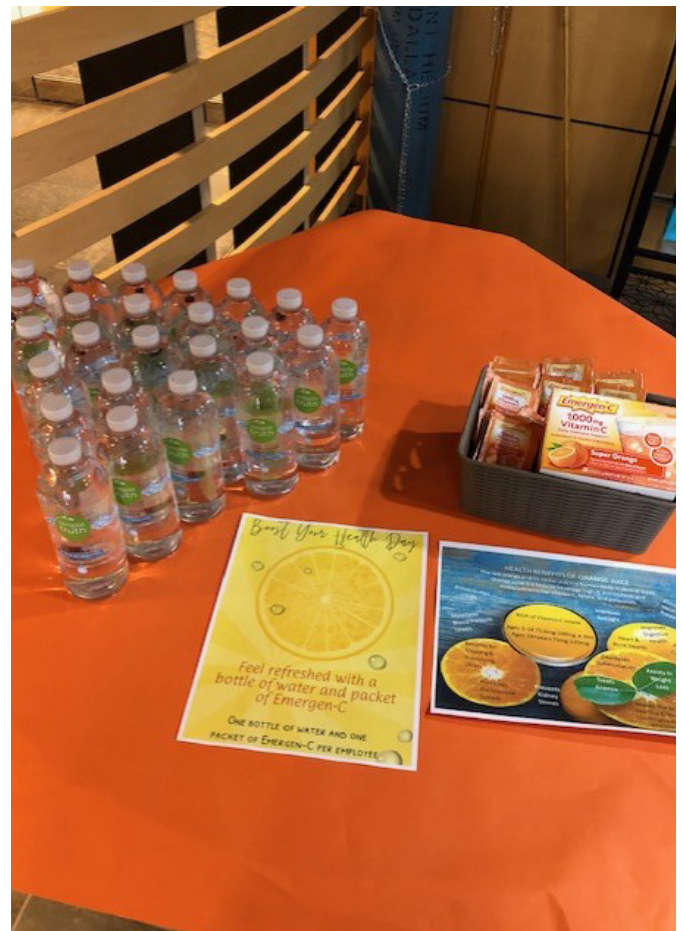

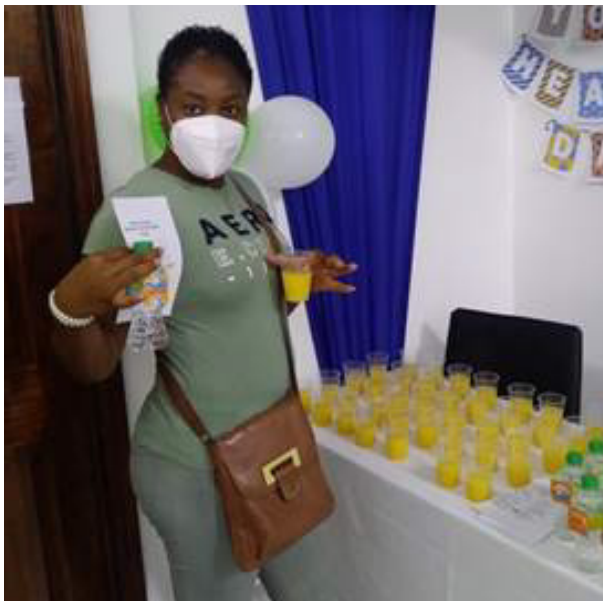
Rusk Train got a Makeover!

Etech Employee Appreciation Initiative - Employee Wall of Fame at Montego Bay

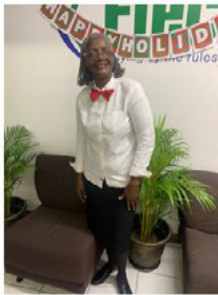

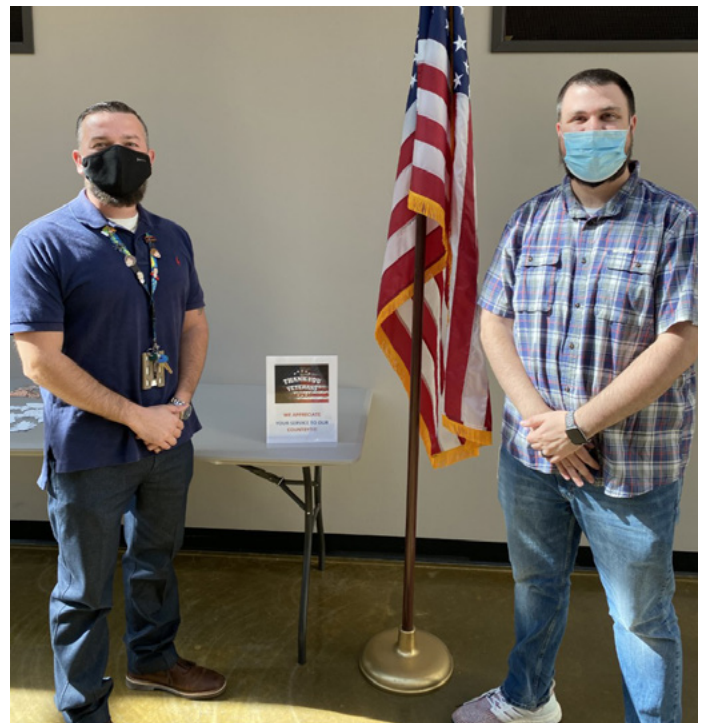
